FROM MADISON, WI:

Follow State Highway 51 North (approx. 15 minutes from inter-section of 51N & Interstate 90/94 / Exit 132) until you reach State Highway 22 North. Follow 22N until you reach Pardeeville (approx. 15 minutes). Once you reach Pardeeville, follow 22N / Main Street until State Highway 44N / East Lake Street and turn right. The entrance to Chandler Park is located on Chandler Park drive, the first street to your left (approx three blocks).

FROM PORTAGE, WI / INTERSTATE:

Follow County Highway 33 East or County Highway 16 East (from I-90/94 or I-39) to State Highway 51 South (also from I-39). Travel 51S until you reach County Highway P (approx 3 miles from downtown Portage, intersection next to BP Station). Take a left onto Cty P and travel approx 8 minutes until you reach Pardeeville. At Main Street (Hwy 22N), turn left. Follow Main Street to State Highway 44N / East Lake Street and turn right. The entrance to Chandler Park is located on Chandler Park drive, the first street to your left (approx three blocks).

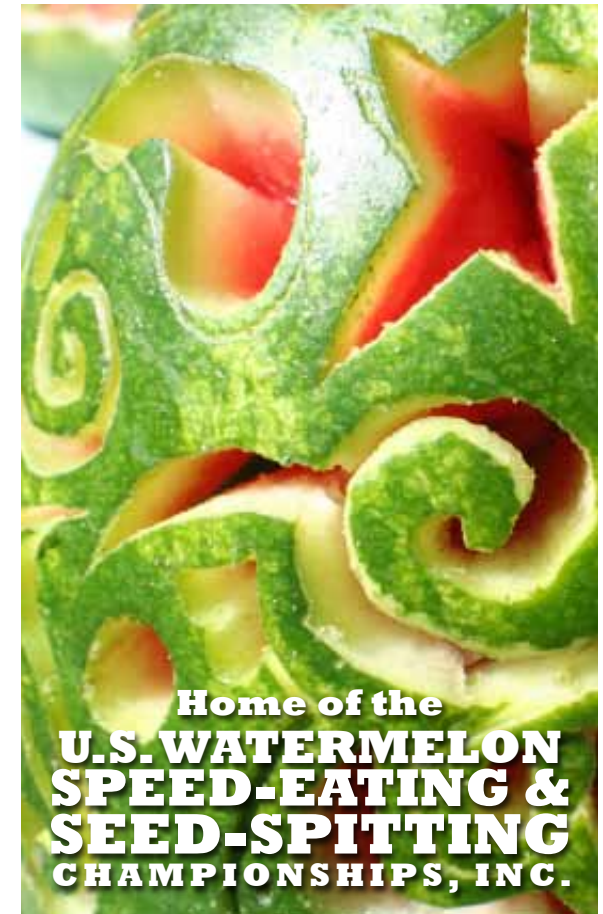
